Hampshire County Council Trading Standards Service continues to receive enquiries from concerned consumers and businesses who have received a telephone call from someone claiming to be from their computer support service. Once the caller has got the consumers attention they may try to:-

- Sell and install software that may damage the computer.
- Request payment details to pay for non existent services.
- Take control of the computer remotely.
- Direct you to fraudulent websites that will ask you for personal and financial information.

Should you receive a similar unsolicited phone call, remember:

<u>DO NOT</u> purchase any software or services.

<u>NEVER</u> give control of your computer to a third party.

<u>NEVER</u> provide your Credit Card or Financial Information.

<u>HANG UP</u> as soon as possible.
