#### **Hampshire Superfast Broad Band**

There is good news and bad news – first the good news, and that is that Damerham and Rockbourne should be included in Wave 2 of the next round of the installation of new "Fibre" boxes.

The installations should start once the finalisation of the plan is completed and that is scheduled for September 2015.

The bad news is that higher speeds of 24+ mbps will only reach some parts of the centre of the village and the outlying areas will continue with only a little benefit, perhaps up to 2.0 mbps!
