## **Dorset CC Highways have released details of the** re-building of the A338 Spur Road.

WITH just a few weeks to go before a £22m project to rebuild the A338 Spur Road gets underway, more details about the necessary traffic restrictions have been revealed by Dorset CC.

Dorset Highways has confirmed that the work, which will start on September 6th, will begin with two weeks of removing vegetation, installing traffic management, speed cameras and CCTV and re-surfacing around Blackwater. There will be day time and night lane closures on both carriage-ways during this fortnight and also some overnight closures.

The reconstruction will be in four phases:

- 1. From September 21st until Christmas, the southbound carriage-way will be reconstructed between Blackwater Junction and the QinetiQ access, with a 40mph contra-flow on the northbound carriageway.
- 2. In the New Year, work will move to the northern end of the scheme, with the reconstruction of the remaining one mile stretch of the southern carriage-way between Ashley Heath Roundabout and the QinetiQ entrance.
- 3. Later on, work will then swap to the northbound carriageway and all traffic will be switched over to the newly-built southern carriage-way.
- 4. From March to the end of May, the northbound carriageway will be reconstructed with the contra-flow traffic on the newly-built southbound side.

Throughout the work there may be times where additional overnight closures are required for surfacing work and to rearrange traffic management. Dorset County Council is urging motorists to start thinking now about whether they can make changes to their driving habits while the project is underway.

The Spur Road will be open in both directions throughout the rebuild but with traffic down to one lane in each direction journeys are likely to take longer at peak times. Motorists could use the train, car share or travel outside of peak times during the rebuild.

The Spur Road, which was opened in 1969, is showing its age and its foundations are failing, meaning that it needs to be totally rebuilt rather than resurfaced.

This project affects the stretch between Ashley Heath roundabout and Blackwater Junction and will also see the installation of a new concrete central safety barrier. The carriage-way width will be brought up to current standards, a 1 metre hard strip will give extra space for cars to move over for emergency vehicles or in case of breakdowns and the road's drainage will be improved.

# **MAKE SURE YOU'RE IN**

#### The Electoral Registration System is changing this summer.

A new, more secure, system of Individual Electoral Registration is being introduced to replace the old system where the "head of household" registered everyone living in a property. Now. each individual will be responsible for registering themselves.

Many New Forest District residents will automatically move onto the new electoral register. However, some will need to take action to join or remain on it, which they will now also be able to do for the first time by registering quickly and easily online.

New Forest District Council's Electoral Registration Officer. Dave Yates said: - "New Forest District residents will receive a letter towards the end of July 2014 that will tell you if you have been automatically transferred to the new register or not.

If you have not been transferred, you will need to provide some additional information and the letter will tell you exactly what vou need to do."

Samantha Mills, Head of Campaigns at the Electoral Commission, said: - "This summer the Electoral Commission will launch a major advertising campaign that will raise awareness of the change to Individual Electoral Registration.

We welcome this change, which will lead to a more secure register and replace the outdated Victorian concept that a single 'head of household' is responsible for registering everyone."
