#### Recycle for Hampshire - Did you know?

In the New Forest District Council area, only 28% of waste is recycled, compared to a national average of 40%!

Apparently this is largely because we aren't clear on what to put in our "clear sacks".

A current campaign to shed light into our darker practices includes this information: -

Around 10% of what people are putting in the "black" sacks collected by NFDC <u>can</u> be recycled, including items such as aerosol cans and plastic bottles.

Councillor Beeton of NFDC says "We need to recycle more of our rubbish. By putting items in the <u>right</u> bag, we will reduce contamination of the clear sacks."

When non-recyclable items such as yoghurt pots and plastic food containers are put in recycling sacks, the whole sack is sent to the energy recovery facility and NOT for recycling!
