### Garden waste collection scheme

Our fortnightly service offers an  
affordable way for New Forest  
residents to recycle their garden  
waste.



#### How it works

The service is a convenient way for you to recycle your  
garden waste, without having to take it to the tip.

On joining for the first time, you will receive a reusable bag  
to store and present your garden waste in for collection.

You will also receive a welcome letter with your collection  
day and a collection calendar.

Your bag(s) will be collected once a fortnight, with the  
exception of a break between mid-December and mid-  
January.

You can use your garden waste bag to dispose of up to 20kg  
of garden waste.

Items that can be included are:

- Grass cuttings
- Hedge cuttings
- Weeds and flowers
- Small branches up to 75mm diameter
- Leaves
- Prunings
