



#### PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES

The **ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY** is on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May at 7pm in the Village Hall. All residents are cordially invited to hear about the Parish Council's plans for the village and to ask questions of the Parish Council. It is your chance to have your say, so please come along!

Those who have looked at the Parish Council Notice Board will have seen that there is a vacancy for a Parish Councillor. If you feel that you would be able to make a contribution to your village please email the Parish Clerk on clerk@damerham.net. Or ring the Chairman, David Crane on 01725 518790.

There is work starting on May 14<sup>th</sup> on **Footpath 49** which runs from the Damerham Fishery to the fields beyond.

This means that this path will be closed for a period of 4 weeks whist new board walks are installed together with a new bridge. We hope that this work will make this important path much more accessible to everyone.

The Parish Council is very conscious of the flooding which occurs regularly on Lower Daggons Lane before the turning to the school. Once the area has dried out there will be work done to try to alleviate the problem.

#### WEST PARK MEADOW

Finally West Park Meadow has new equipment installed as suggested by residents, in the form of a large circular picnic bench with seats and a swing for toddlers. There are also new signs at each end of the Meadow welcoming everyone and warning parents of young children about the fast flowing stream.

A programme of events is planned for the Meadow during the summer. TUFF (Turn Up for Fun ) will be running a series of sessions for children during the school holidays. More details in next month's Pump.
