Parish Council Updates

Unfortunately, at short notice County Councillor Edward Heron was unable to attend the **Annual Parish Assembly** on 20th May due to NFDC commitments, however the Parish Council were delighted to welcome **PCSO Stephen May - our local 'bobby'**.

PCSO May detailed the structure of our local Fordingbridge policing team, with himself and PC Neale being responsible for Damerham. He explained the police report specific to our region - Downlands and Forest. In 12 months, there were 60 reported incidents, of which 29 were crimes.

Community SpeedWatch training will be carried out in early June – get in touch with the clerk if you are interested...the more volunteers the merrier!
