Mary Toynton



Speedwatch has returned to the village as requested by some residents. We have a new trained group who are giving up their time to try and educate drivers coming through our village too

From the data to date, they have found that of the 191 vehicles monitored, 100 of these were travelling at over 30mph, this is 52% of vehicles passing either in or out of the village. The highest number of speeding vehicles is early morning and late afternoon. It is hoped that by frequent checks, it will educate those speeders to drive responsibly within the 30mph limit in the village.

The fastest speed recorded to date was 45mph! We will provide regular updates via the Pump.
